REGISTRATION TO VOTE TAKES PLACE ON VOTING DAY: If you qualify to vote you **DO NOT** register **PRIOR** to election day. Registration of all electors for this election will take place at the time of voting. You will be required to make a declaration that you meet the following requirements:

- ✓ 18 years of age or older;
- ✓ Canadian citizen;
- ✓ Resident of BC for at least 6 months immediately preceding voting day;
- ✓ Resident of OR registered owner of real property in the District of Hope for at least 30 days immediately preceding voting day; and
- ✓ Not otherwise disqualified by law from voting because you have been convicted of an indictable offence for which you are currently in custody; or have been found guilty of an election offence.

In order to register on election day, you **MUST** produce **2 PIECES OF IDENTIFICATION** (at least one with a signature) to election staff at the voting place. Picture identification is not necessary. The identification must prove both residency and identity.

Non-resident property electors MUST produce **2 PIECES OF IDENTIFICATION** (at least one with a signature) to prove identity, proof that they are entitled to register in relation to the property. If there are other owners of the same property you must also have written consent from the majority of all the owners stating that you are the one owner designated as the Non-Resident (Property) Elector for that property. A consent form is available at the District Hall or visit our website at www.hope.ca to download the “*Non-Resident Consent*” form and bring the completed form with you to the voting place.

Acceptable identification includes two (2) of:

- ✓ BC Driver’s License
- ✓ ICBC Vehicle Insurance documents
- ✓ BC Identification Card
- ✓ BC CareCard or Gold CareCard
- ✓ Citizenship Card
- ✓ District of Hope Tax Notice
- ✓ Social Insurance Card
- ✓ Utility Bill
- ✓ Credit Card
